1. To appear in First Counselling for admission in BTech Course at Engineering Wing, Punjabi University, Patiala candidate needs to apply on www.pupadmissions.ac.in latest by the last date of registration. The interested Candidates will have to register-online on the above website after paying the Counselling/Processing Fee of Rs. 2000/- for General Category; and Rs. 1400/- for SC/ST Category Candidates. The Counselling/Processing fee can be paid via Online Net-banking and other available modes.
2. Applicants must read and adhere to the attached instructions regarding counselling.
3. The Eligibility, Fee details and Seat matrix mentioning seats available against different categories are mentioned in the **B.Tech /M.Tech Handbook of Information (2021-22)** available at the university admission website ‘www.pupadmissions.ac.in.’
4. The applicants must attend the counselling with all the desired certificates / documents in the prescribed formats, as mentioned in the **B.Tech /M.Tech Handbook of Information (2021-22)** and fees (refer counselling instructions attached).

Instructions for First Counselling

B. Tech. (CSE, ECE, ECM, ME, CIVIL)

The applicants must ensure that they have passed 10+2 Examination at the time of counselling. They must carry their original certificates and submit attested photo-copies of the certificates and other relevant documents (during physical verification), as mentioned below. The Candidates seeking admission under Sports Category must have their original Gradation Certificate. Applicants must take care of following instructions for participation in counselling:

1. Admission Criteria

Admission shall be made on the merit of aggregate of three subjects of 10+2 Physics & Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with any one subject amongst Chemistry/ Biotechnology/ Biology/Technical Vocational subject/ Computer Science/Information Technology/ Informatics Practices/Agriculture/ Engineering Graphics/ Business Studies/ Electronics/ Entrepreneurship and etc. In case of a tie in the merit list prepared as per above criteria, the same shall be broken on the basis of below mentioned "Tie-Breaker" criteria precedence wise.

Tie-Breaker: In case of tie in Admission criteria (upto 3rd decimal place), the following order shall be used precedence wise to break it: 1. Higher Marks in Mathematics in 10+2 Examination 2. Higher Marks in Physics in 10+2 Examination 3. Higher Marks in English in 10+2 Examination 4. Higher Marks/CGPA in 10th Examination. 5. Candidates older in age to be preferred. In case of any requirement for the tie resolution and subsequent updation in the above criteria, the decision of the committee constituted by Punjabi University, Patiala will be final.

2. List of Documents required for Counselling

The verification of the original certificates and testimonials will be done by the verification committee, during counselling. Thereafter, the admitted candidates will have to submit Self Photograph (04 Nos.), Photograph of Parent/Guardian (01 No.), and one set of Photo-copies of the following Documents/Certificates, as per format supplied in the Handbook of Information 2021-2022 (B. Tech. Courses):-

Note: Uploading of highlighted documents at serial No 1-4 as above is mandatory .The original copy of all the certificates must be produced at the time of counselling.

3. COURSE FEE

The applicant has to deposit full course fee at the time of confirmation of seat offered to him/her, otherwise, the offered seat shall stand cancelled and will be offered to the next applicant in merit list. The following fees should be deposited in the form of separate **DEMAND DRAFTS payable at PATIALA** as per details mentioned below:

1. ₹ 59248/- in favor of "**Registrar, Punjabi University, Patiala**".

OR

Only for SC/ST applicants whose family income is Less than <2.5 Lakhs per annum.

***Rs 2000/- in favor of "Registrar, Punjabi University, Patiala"**

2. ₹ 1000/- (SAF Fund) in favor of "SAF_CE"; (Compulsory for all admitted candidates.)(Non- Refundable)

FEE IS NOT ACCEPTABLE IN CHEQUE.

Note: The applicants without Demand Drafts or Cash Fee ₹ 59248 shall not be allotted seats.

4. The applicant seeking admission under reserved category must present the relevant Category Certificate(s), as applicable at the time of counselling, The Certificate must conform to the format(s) provided in 'Handbook of Information: 2021-2022 (B. Tech. & M. Tech.)', available at university website www.pupadmissions.ac.in. Failing to do so, the applicant's claim for admission in the reserved category will be forfeited.
5. The order of preference of the branches (CSE/ECE/ECM/ME/CIVIL) given by the applicant at the time of filing of their Admission / Registration Form will be treated as the final.
6. The applicants with incomplete/inappropriate documents will not be considered for seat allotment. In case of Non-deposit of Course fee the applicants claim for admission will be forfeited.
7. Seats falling vacant during the ongoing counselling process due to seat surrender or branch change, will be offered only to the candidates in the waiting list. The candidates registered after First Counselling will be considered only after exhaustion of the existing waiting list.
8. The applicants should note that seat allocation in First Counselling will be made strictly on the basis of merit as per notified admission criteria. However, the applicants reporting late in the ongoing counselling will be allotted seat if available at that time (provided he/she fulfils eligibility criteria).
9. **Cancellation of admission for furnishing Incorrect Information:** The admission of a student in B. Tech. course is liable to be cancelled at any time, on being found, ineligible or unfit for admission, or of using fraudulent means for securing admission or using false or incorrect statement(s) for getting admission. University shall have the right to take disciplinary action and/or impose penalty, as per its policy/rules. In such case, the fee deposited by the student shall be forfeited and he/she shall also be liable to pay the pending fee for the remaining duration of the course and dues, penalty etc., whatsoever is applicable.
10. **In case of seat surrender** by the candidates, the fee shall be refunded as per rules mentioned in the Handbook of Information 2021. Last Date of Admission will be announced as per guidelines of AICTE or Government.
11. Hostel Allocation will be done only after the announcement regarding the start of teaching activities for First Year at the university.
