Eligibility and Merit Criterion for Admission to B. Tech. in CSE for Second Counselling:

Eligibility: Passed 10+2 examination, with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with any one subject among Chemistry/ Biotechnology/ Biology/Technical Vocational subject/ Computer Science/Information Technology/ Informatics Practices/Agriculture/ Engineering Graphics/ Business Studies, having minimum aggregate of 50% marks for General Category and 45% marks for SC/ST and Disabled Persons Category.

Admission Criteria: The Admission shall be made on the basis of merit of rank of JEE Mains (All India Rank). In case of unavailability of applications in some category or seats remain vacant after allocation to candidates with JEE Score, the admission will be made on the basis of merit of aggregate % Marks (upto 3rd decimal place) of three subjects namely, Physics, Mathematics and any one subject out of Chemistry/ Biotechnology/ Biology/Technical Vocational subject/ Computer Science/Information Technology/ Informatics Practices/Agriculture/ Engineering Graphics/Business Studies.

Seat Allocation & Waiting List: Seat will be allocated to candidate according to admission Criteria and Preferences filled in the online form. A waiting list (as per admission criteria) will be prepared for all the registered candidates having CSE as 1st preference and registered on or before 21st August 2022. The candidates registering late will be offered only vacant seats after offering/upgrading waiting list candidates.

Tie-Breaker: In case of tie at overall % Marks (upto 3rd decimal place) obtained by the students in 10+2/PCM, the following order shall be used precedence wise to break the tie: 1. Candidates obtaining higher Marks in Mathematics in 10+2 Examination 2. Candidates obtaining higher Marks in Physics in 10+2 Examination, 3. Candidates obtaining higher Marks in Chemistry in 10+2 Examination, 4. Candidates obtaining higher Marks in English in 10+2 Examination, 5. Candidates with overall higher Marks/CGPA in 10th Examination. 6. Candidates older in age to be preferred. In case of any requirement for the tie resolution and subsequent updation in the above criteria, the decision of committee constituted by Punjabi University, Patiala will be final.

Instructions for 2nd Counselling (ONLINE)

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All the admissions will be provisional subject to physical verification of the documents of the admitted candidates. The verification of the original certificates and testimonials will be done by the departmental verification committee as per schedule, to be notified later on by department. The admitted candidates will also have to submit Self Photograph (04 Nos.), Photograph of Parent/Guardian (01 No.), and one set of Photo-copies of the following Documents/Certificates, as per format supplied in the Handbook of Information 2022-2023 (B. Tech. Courses) at that time:-

- 1) The applicants must ensure that they have passed 10+2 Examination at the time of online counselling. They must upload following documents at Google Form <https://forms.gle/Zti5j2F2kLrYBRjWA> latest by 21st August 2022:

- (a) Result/rank card of JEE Mains 2022
- (b) DMC/Mark Sheet/Result of 10+2
- (c) Category Certificate (if any)

- 2) The applicant seeking admission under reserved category must ensure that relevant Category Certificate(s) is available as per University/Govt. Norms, as applicable at the time of counselling, to claim their seat in respective category. Failing to do so, the applicant's claim for admission in the reserved category will be forfeited.
- 3) **SEAT ALLOTMENT & COURSE FEE:** Allotment list for vacant seats will be uploaded on website www.pupengg.in as per schedule. The selected applicant will be required to deposit the course fee after each allotment list as per the mode and time period specified, failing which the seat allotted to the candidate is liable to be cancelled and will be offered to the next applicant in the waiting list. Next Allotment list (if any) will be uploaded for the vacant seats after last date of Fee deposit and process will continue till filling of all the seats. The details of fees to be deposited via online mode is mentioned below:

Semester Fee:

- **Rs 59424/-* through online/offline mode (Payment instructions will be made available with allotment list)**
- **Only for SC/ST applicants of Punjab residence whose family income is Less than <2.5 Lakhs per annum (valid certificate of income as a proof) has to deposit Rs 2000/-**

- 4) **REFUND OF FEE:** In case of seat surrender by the candidates, the fee shall be refunded as per rules mentioned in the Handbook of Information 2022.
- 5) The tentative status of vacant seats and allocation will be notified on Punjabi University admissions website i.e. pupadmissions.ac.in.
- 6) The order of preference of the branches (CSE/ECE/ECM/ME/CIVIL) given by the applicant at the time of filing of their Admission / Registration Form will be treated as the final.
- 7) The applicants with incomplete/inappropriate documents and non-deposit of Course fee will be treated as ineligible. However, such candidates may be considered for admission, as and when they report with the required fee receipt and produce the pending documents, subject to the availability of vacant seats at that time.
- 8) Seats falling vacant during the ongoing counselling process due to seat surrender, will be offered only to the candidates in the waiting list.
- 9) **Cancellation of admission for furnishing Incorrect Information:** The admission of a student in B. Tech. course is liable to be cancelled at any time, on being found, ineligible or unfit for admission, or of using fraudulent means for securing admission or using false or incorrect statement(s) for getting admission. University shall have the right to take disciplinary action and/or impose penalty, as per its policy/rules. In such case, the fee deposited by the student shall be forfeited and he/she shall also be liable to pay the pending fee for the remaining duration of the course and dues, penalty etc., whatsoever is applicable.
- 10) Hostel Allocation will be done only after the announcement regarding the start of teaching activities at the university.
