Physical Counselling for these vacant seats has been scheduled on 22nd June, 2023 in Lab No. 122, Engineering Wing Building, Punjabi University, Patiala. Candidates who are eligible in any of these categories need to report as per schedule and instructions.

Important Note(s):

- 1. All the candidates who have already registered by filling Form No. 18 with BTech CSE as their First Preference, need not to fill the registration form again.*
- 2. Candidates who have not filled the Form No. 18 with BTech CSE as their first preference will need to fill the Online Registration Form (Form No. 18) on 22nd June, 2023 during the counselling.*

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Instructions for Second round of counselling for vacant Seats

The applicants must ensure that they have passed 10+2 Examination at the time of counselling. They must carry their original certificates and submit self-attested photo-copies of the certificates and other relevant documents (during physical verification), as mentioned below. The applicants seeking admission under Sports Category must produce their original Graduation Certificate. Applicants must take care of the following instructions for participation in the counselling:

1. Admission Criteria

1. Candidates will be admitted on the basis of their merit (All India CRL) in JEE (Mains)-2023 entrance test as per the schedule and guidelines notified on Punjabi University website (www.pupadmissions.ac.in). 2. If the seats remain vacant after allotment to the applicants based on JEE (Mains) - 2023 entrance these vacant seats will be offered to pass-out students of 10+2 on the basis of merit of aggregate of three subjects of 10+2, Physics & Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with any one subject amongst Chemistry/ Biotechnology/ Biology/Technical Vocational subject/ Computer Science/Information Technology/ Informatics Practices/Agriculture/ Engineering Graphics/ Business Studies/ Electronics/ Entrepreneurship and etc.

In case of a tie in the merit list prepared as per the above criterion, the same shall be resolved on the basis of the below mentioned “Tie-Breaker” criteria, precedence wise.

Tie-Breaker: In case of tie in the admission criterion mentioned above (upto 3rd decimal place), the following order shall be used, precedence wise, to break the tie: 1. Higher Marks in Mathematics in 10+2 Examination, 2. Higher Marks in Physics in 10+2 Examination, 3. Higher Marks in English in 10+2 Examination, 4. Higher Marks/CGPA in 10th Examination, 5. Candidates older in age to be preferred. In case of any further need for the tie resolution and necessary modification in the above criteria, the decision of the committee constituted by the Punjabi University, Patiala will be final.

2. List of Documents required for Counselling

The verification of the original certificates and testimonials will be done by the verification committee, during the counselling. Thereafter, the admitted candidates will have to submit own Photograph (04 Nos.), Photograph of Parent/Guardian (01 No.), and one set of Photo-copies of the following Documents/Certificates, as per format supplied in the Handbook of Information (2023-24) B.Tech. / M.Tech.:-

Certificates No. 1 to 5 and 6 (If applicable) are to be compulsorily produced at the time of physical counselling.

3. COURSE FEE

The applicant has to deposit full course fee (Demand Draft / Cash) at the time of confirmation of seat offered to him/her, otherwise, the offered seat shall stand cancelled and will be offered to the next applicant in the merit list. The following fees should be deposited preferably in the form of separate **DEMAND DRAFTS** (for a & b) payable at **PATIALA** as per the details mentioned below:

a. **Rs. 59496/- in favor of "Registrar, Punjabi University, Patiala"**
[Note: **Only for SC/ST applicants of Punjab residence whose family income is Less than <2.5 Lakhs per annum (valid certificate of income needed as a proof) has to deposit Rs 2000/- in favor of "Registrar, Punjabi University, Patiala"**]

b. **Rs. 1000/- (SAF Fund) in favor of "SAF_CE"; (Compulsory for all the admitted candidates) (non-refundable).**

Note: i) Fee will not be acceptable in the form of cheque, but can be deposited in cash on the spot.

4. The applicant seeking admission under the reserved category must produce the relevant Category Certificate(s), as applicable at the time of counselling, The Certificate must confirm to the format(s) provided in the 'Handbook of Information: 2023-2024 (B. Tech. & M. Tech.)', available at University website <https://pupadmissions.ac.in/>. Failing to do so, the applicant's claim for admission to the reserved category is liable to be forfeited.
5. The applicants with incomplete/inappropriate documents will not be considered for seat allotment.
6. The seat allocation in the Second Counselling will be done strictly on the basis of merit, as per the notified admission criteria. The applicants reporting late during the counselling will be allotted the seat, if available, at that time (provided he/she fulfils eligibility criteria).
7. **Cancellation of admission for furnishing Incorrect Information:** The admission of a student to B. Tech. course is liable to be cancelled at any time, on being found, ineligible or unfit for admission, or of using fraudulent means for securing admission or using false or incorrect statement(s) for getting admission. University shall have the right to take disciplinary action and/or impose penalty, as per its policy/rules. In such case, the fee deposited by the candidate shall be forfeited and he/she shall also be liable to pay the pending fee for the remaining duration of the course, dues, penalty etc., whatsoever is applicable.
8. **In case of seat surrender** by the candidate, the fee shall be refunded as per the rules mentioned in the Handbook of Information 2023. The last date of admission will be announced as per the guidelines of AICTE/Punjab Government/Punjabi University, Patiala.
9. Hostel Allocation to the admitted candidates will be done only after the announcement of the Academic Calendar for the first year by the respective departments as per merit.
